**Access Medicine**: Mobile downloads are available for Diagnosaurus as well as for specific content from electronic textbooks and the "Quick Answers" section.

**Dynamed**: To get mobile access to Dynamed, contact <a href="mailto:dynamedsupport@epnet.com">dynamedsupport@epnet.com</a> from your Kaiser Lotus Notes e-mail. They will send you a serial number to activate your account.

First Consult: Evidence-based disease topics are available for your mobile. Create a free personal account on MD Consult, then download the First Consult app from the iTunes store and access it using that name and password.

## **KP Formulary (Lexi-Comp)**:
